
Subject : In pursuance of Section 18 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009, Rule 11, sub-rule (4) of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2021 regarding the issue of recognition certificates to school.

With reference to the application No 4076946/2026 Dt.20/04/2026 on the above subject and subsequent correspondence with the school in this regard/ based on inspection of the school.

I Education Officer (Primary) Zilla Parishad Yavatmal granting provisional recognition to the above school for class 1st to 8th for the year period from Dt. 01/04/2026 To 31/03/2029

The above approval is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- 1) The period of recognition shall not be extended and there shall be no obligation under any circumstances to grant recognition or affiliation after Class VIII.
- 2) The school shall comply with the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure One) and the Maharashtra Right to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 (Annexure Two).
- 3) The school shall admit children belonging to the nearest weaker sections and disadvantaged groups, in the first grade, to the extent of at least 25% of the number of students in that grade and shall provide free compulsory education to them up to the completion of primary education provided that, in the case of pre-primary grade also, this ratio shall be complied with.
- 4) For the children specified in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed in accordance with section 12(2) of the Act. A separate bank account will be provided to the school to receive such reimbursement.
- 5) The Institution/School shall not charge any fee and shall not compel the child or his/her mother/father or guardian for any screening procedure.
- 6) No child shall be denied admission to school for want of proof of age, religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of these grounds.
- 7) i. No child admitted to a school shall be held back in the same grade as he is or expelled from school till completion of primary education.
ii. No child shall be subjected to corporal punishment or mental torture.
iii. No child shall be required to pass any board examination till completion of primary education.
iv. Every child who has completed primary education shall be given a certificate as prescribed under rule 23.
v. Students with disabilities/special needs will be included as per the provisions of the Act
vi. Teachers possessing the minimum qualification prescribed under section 23(1) of the Act shall be appointed, provided further that teachers who do not possess the minimum qualification on the date of commencement of the Act shall acquire such minimum qualification within a period of 5 years.
vii. The teacher shall perform his/her duties as specified in section 24(1) of the Act.
viii. Schools shall ensure that male / female teachers do not engage themselves in private teaching.
- 8) The school shall follow the syllabus prepared on the basis of the syllabus prescribed by the appropriate authority.

9. The school shall admit students against the facilities available in the school as prescribed in section 19 of the Act.
10. Adherence to Standards and Standards specified in Section 19 of the Schools Act The facilities available in the school at the time of last inspection were as follows.
 - Area of school premises.
 - Total construction.
 - Area of the playground.
 - Number of classrooms.
 - Office, Storeroom, Principal's Room.
 - Separate toilets for boys and girls with sufficient water for use and keeping the toilets in a clean and hygienic condition.
 - Drinking water facility.
 - Kitchen to cook lunch.
 - Availability of teaching study material/sports and sports material/library.
 - Free availability of reading materials.
11. Unapproved classes or units may not be conducted in the name of the school in the school premises or elsewhere.
12. The school building and other structures or playgrounds shall be used only for the purpose of education and skill development only.
13. The schools are run by institutions registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860) or the Bombay Public Works Act, 1950.
14. The school is being run for the benefit of any group or association of persons or any other person or for making any profit.
15. Accounts of the school should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper statement of accounts should be prepared as per rules. A copy of each account statement should be sent to the District Education Officer every year.
16. The accreditation code received by your school is 27141503012 Please note that this should be mentioned in any correspondence with this office.
17. The school shall submit such reports and information as or when required by the Director of Education/ District Education Officer from time to time or comply with such instructions as or when given by the Government or the local authority for the continued fulfillment of the conditions of approval of the school or for the removal of defects in the functioning of the school.
18. Ensure it any renewal of the organization's registration is done.
